# Get Set for Work Program Information Sheet

## Program Overview

Anglicare Southern Qld is delighted to present an exciting opportunity for eligible unemployed youth, incl. culturally diverse and First Nation's people to join our Get Set for Work program based in Logan.

Students will complete a **Certificate III in Individual Support** through TAFE Qld which will qualify them to obtain employment in Aged Care, Community or Disability Services.

Included in the learning program will be **First Aid**, and the much sought after skillset of **Recognise Healthy Body Systems** and **Assist Clients with Medication**.

With **no charge to participants**, this Skilling Queenslanders for Work project is proudly funded by the Queensland Government.

## Learning Facilitator

This is a unique program in that Anglicare has appointed a Learning Facilitator who will accompany the students in the classroom to offer encouragement, provide support and coordinate with the TAFE teacher to address any barriers to learning they may encounter.

## Student Placement

Anglicare will be providing 120 hrs of supervised placement where students will experience a range of aspects of delivering support to clients in the community.

## Employment Support

Following graduation (which will be celebrated with family and friends), our Learning Facilitator will support participants with a further 2 week employment skills program.

## Who is Eligible?

Youth aged 15 years and over and who are disadvantaged by:

- being ineligible for Australian Govt. employment services or assistance
- requiring complementary services because they have significant barriers to learning & employment
- having accessed Australian Govt services for more than six months and remain unemployed

## Program Duration

The program will run over a 25 week period (incl employment skills), commencing **April 8th 2019**.

## Student Commitment

Student commitment will be for 3 days per week plus 6 hours of self-directed study time.
